The School of Mechanical, Industrial and Manufacturing Engineering (MIME) at Oregon State University invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position within the area of design starting Fall 2018. Exceptionally strong candidates at all levels (assistant, associate, and full) are encouraged to apply. Applicants must hold a doctorate in a relevant field. The successful candidates are expected to initiate new funded research as well as expand, complement, and collaborate with existing research programs in the school, in the College of Engineering, and beyond.

Oregon State is located in Corvallis, at the heart of Oregon's Willamette Valley. Surrounded by forests and mountains, Corvallis combines the amenities of a college town with ample opportunity for outdoor recreation and fresh local food. Portland, the Cascade mountain range, and the Oregon Coast are all within easy reach.
