GENERAL INFORMATION: All decisions of the Judges and Horse Board are FINAL

Classes will be combined, canceled or divided at the discretion of the Horse Board.

The exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1, of the year they are exhibiting.

Checks returned for insufficient funds will be accessed an additional \$25.00 fee.

4-H Bulletin 1145 will govern all classes pertaining to equipment, tack, rules, etc. Chaps are optional in all Stock Seat classes.

Exhibitors will wear proper dress and horses will be in proper tack for all classes entered. Exhibitors will use the two-handed method of showing in all Fitting and Showing classes. **Sign-up for desired classes must be done TWO FULL CLASSES in advance. No refunds will be given.**

Hunter Hack class - Horses and/or ponies will be shown at the walk, trot, canter, and hand gallop both ways of the ring and will be required to jump two (2) obstacles that will be set in the middle of the ring. Schooling jump decided by Horse Board.

All exhibitors in Hunt Seat (both over fences and on the flat), Dressage, Saddle Seat, Bareback, Trail, English/Western Pattern, Reining and Gymkhana classes are required to wear ASTM/SEI approved protective riding helmets.

- i. Helmets are required to be worn by all riders age 9 and under at all times.
- ii. All riders must wear helmets in the warm up ring and ANY TIME WHEN MOUNTED OUTSIDE THE SHOW RING. Proper riding attire is required at all times, including the warm up ring.

Trail classes will begin running at 10:00 a.m. Check at Announcer's Stand for location.

Horses may ONLY be tied at horse trailers. They may NOT be tied in the wash rack areas.

Before you leave the grounds, we ask that you clean the area around your trailer.

All exhibitors are enrolled in High Point. High Point is one rider/one horse. Points for high point are assigned as follows, regardless of number of entries: 6 points for 1st, 5 points for 2nd, 4 points for 3rd, 3 points for 4th, 2 points for 5th, and 1 point for 6th. Counting the number of 1st placings, etc. will break high point ties.
